The Knockdown Severity Chart is an advanced house rule, presented as an alternative to the basic WIL roll to recover from a knockdown. This chart will produce varying levels of knockdowns taking both POW of the attacking fighter and the WIL of the downed fighter as factors. How to use it:

- When a Knockdown is scored, compare the POW of the scoring fighter to the WIL of the downed fighter. The difference is the level of advantage for the higher rating. Roll a 20-sided die in the corresponding row to determine the value of the knockdown.

A 5 or 6 point knockdown grants two Finisher rolls, while a 4-point knockdown grants one Finisher roll.
